# General waste container, what goes in?

**Flexible and soft plastic packaging**

**Contaminated materials**

**Soiled products**

**Crisp packets, foil wrappers, cling film, and non-recyclable wrapping paper.**

**Clean paper, card, tins, cans or plastic containers • Food • Glass • Electrical or battery-operated devices and products**

# Plastics - what goes in?

**Yes** ✓

**Rigid bottles, tubs and trays**

pots (e.g. yoghurt, soup)

tubs (e.g. ice cream, spreadable butter)

trays (e.g. raw meat, fruit and vegetable trays)

- remove any film lids and absorbent pads in the bottom of the tray and put these in general rubbish  
chocolate and biscuit tubs

**Must be cleaned**

**Plastic wrapping**

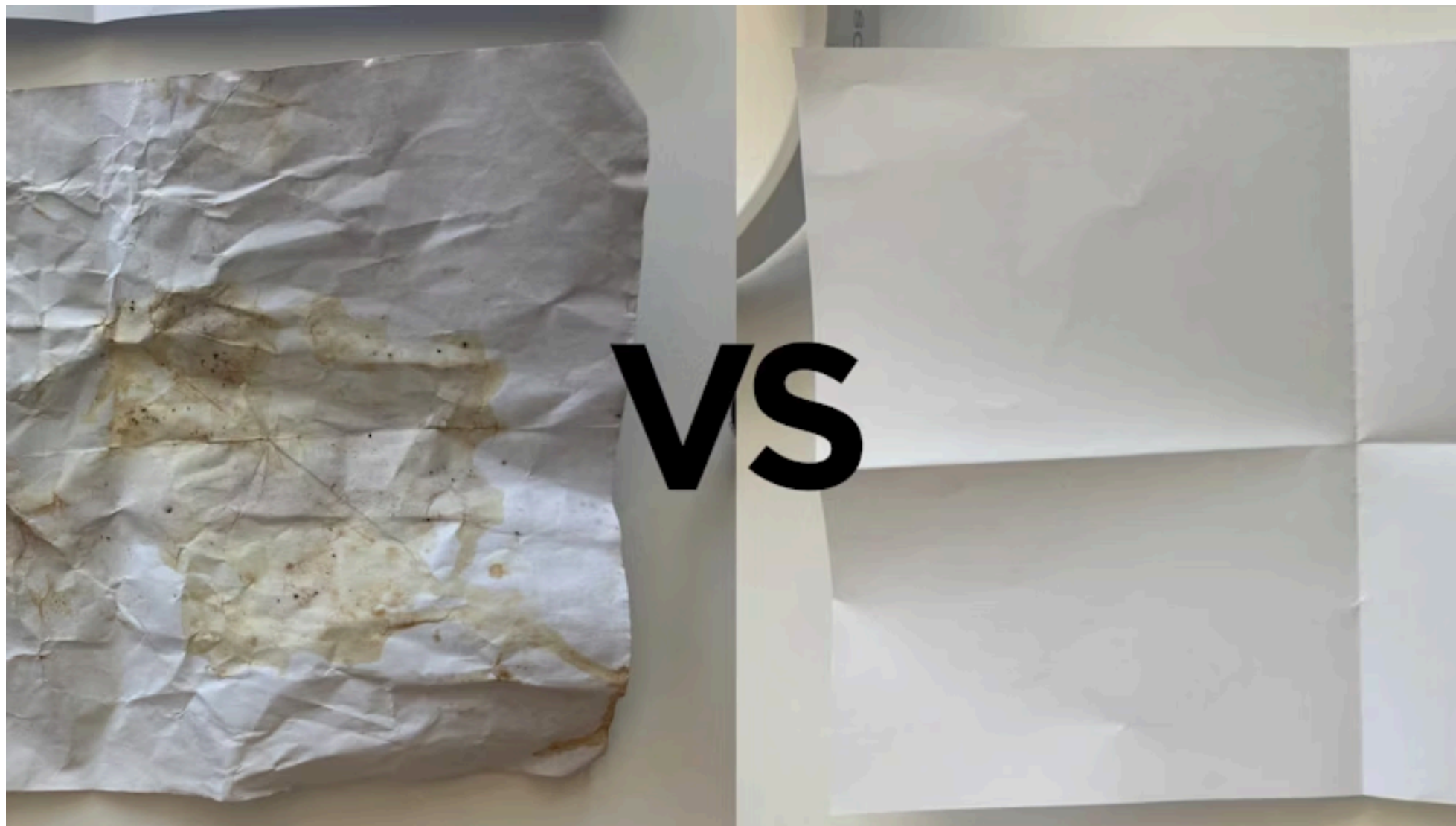
crisp packets and sweet wrappers
